Richmond City Centre Urgent and Primary Care Centre (UPCC)

If you can't see your primary care provider (family doctor or nurse practitioner), you can go to the Richmond City Centre UPCC for non-life-threatening illnesses or injuries such as:

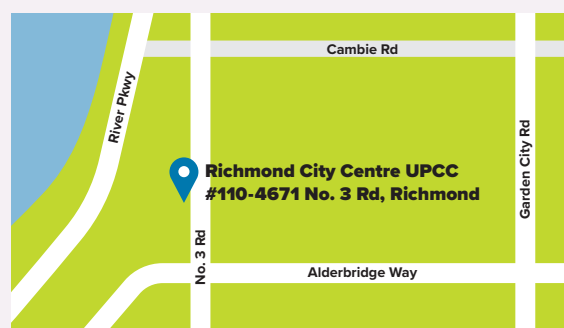
- Sprains and strains
- Cuts, wounds or skin conditions
- Fever
- Infections (chest, ear & urinary tract, etc.)
- Asthma
- New or worsening pain
- Less serious child illness & injury
- Worsening chronic disease
- Dehydration/constipation
