NALOXONE ADMINISTRATION

- 3hr classroom course (in-person and virtual options)
- Recommended for all staff, is a great starting point for learning related to substance use care.
- Topics include: Stigma & engagement, • Harm reduction principles, trauma informed care, inclusive language and more!

OVERDOSE SAFETY PLANNING

- 1.5hr virtual training
- Reviews the Overdose Prevention Safety Planning Standard Operating Procedure

NALOXONE KIT DISTRIBUTION

- 2.5hr virtual training
- Specifically for distributing naloxone kits to clients and/or eligible members of the public

ONLINE STREET DEGREE - ADVANCED OVERDOSE RESPONSE - MANAGING MEDICAL EMERGENCIES - FIRST RESPONDER COLLABORATION

• 3 online courses designed for peers and others working on the frontlines at overdose prevention/supervised consumption sites and/or in outreach.

HEART AND SOUL OF MENTAL HEALTH AND SUBSTANCE USE (MHSU)

- 2 day orientation to core concepts in MHSU
- Topics include: Trauma-Informed Practice, Family involvement, Harm Reduction, Recovery Model, Substance Use, Mental Heath Act, Indigenous Cultural Safety.
- In-person or virtual, offered monthly
