

GETTING FAIR PHARMACARE COVERAGE

Fair PharmaCare (B.C.'s largest drug plan) helps B.C. families pay for eligible prescription drugs, despensing fees and some medical supplies.

Follow these steps to sign up for Fair PharmaCare

Are you signed up for Medical Services Plan (MSP)?

Apply for your MSP and Fair PharmaCare using one form. For more information scan the QR code or Google *MSP enrollment*.

Check to see if you are registered for Fair PharmaCare

Scan the QR code or Google *Fair Pharmacare registration status.*



You will need your Personal Health Number (PHN), which can be found on your Care Card or on the back of your licence, and income tax information (from 2 years ago).

Get help paying your Fair PharmaCare deductibles by visiting the <u>Fair PharmaCare</u> <u>site</u> for options, such as income review or options to spread deductible payments or scan the QR code.

Reach out to <u>free tax clinics</u> in your community, Google *free tax clinic* or scan the QR Code.
