Locations

Vancouver is a vibrant metropolitan city with easy access to the Pacific Ocean and the Coast Mountain Range. It is recognized as one of the most livable cities in the world. The Vancouver metropolitan area is home to a *multicultural* population of more than 2.6 million residents.

In recent years, the Greater Victoria area has seen a growing predominance of residents from Chinese, South Asian, and Filipino heritages.
