Case Study

Your patient has been prescribed Methadone. What education should you provide?

Answer

When: before medication administration, prior to discharge, as needed

- Common side effects
 - o Constipation, drowsiness and should not be confused with withdrawal symptoms
- Overdose signs, symptoms, and prevention strategies.
 - o Caution: mixing opioids and CNS depressants unless prescribed and monitored
- Titration to a stable dose takes time.
 - o Doses of 150mg or higher may be required to meet therapeutic goals
- Methadone is most effective as a long-term treatment
 - o Follow up with a community provider for continual/maintenance treatment
