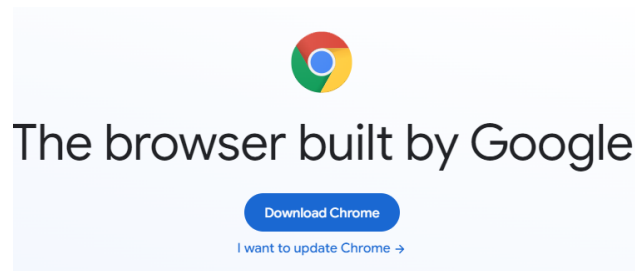


Get the right web browser and allow pop-ups:

To take an Online Street Degree course, you'll need to use a laptop or a computer. The courses do not work properly on a mobile device.

You will also need your laptop or computer to be using a Chrome Browser. If you don't already use Chrome, please download it by googling 'download Chrome' and downloading the version of Chrome that is right for your computer.



Create a LearningHub account and start a course:

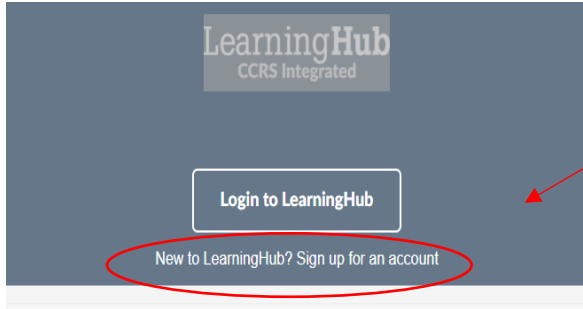
Once you have your Chrome web browser open, you'll need to make yourself a free account at LearningHub.

To create a LearningHub account:

1. Go to <https://learninghub.phsa.ca/Learner/Home>
2. Click on 'New to LearningHub? Sign up for an account'
3. Learninghub will ask you not to create multiple accounts (if you don't have a Learninghub account already, just click continue).
4. You will need to use an existing email account to create a LearningHub account.
5. Create a new account by filling out your Name, Email and Password.
6. Choose a password you will remember. If you can, write it down somewhere or note it in your phone or take a picture of it with your phone. If you forget your password, you can request a password reset be sent to your email address.
7. The last step to creating your LearningHub account is activating it. To do so, go to your email account that you signed up with. You'll see a confirmation email from LearningHub.

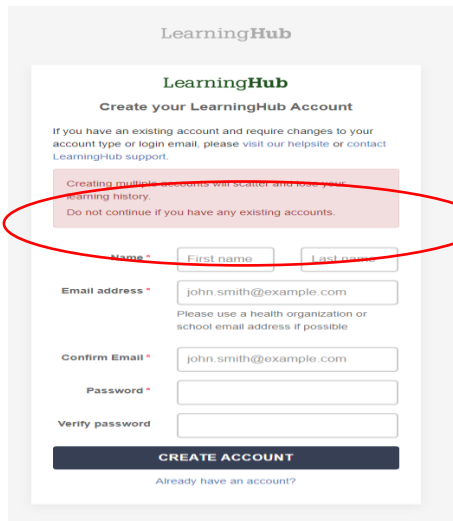
How to access Online Street Degree

Go to <https://learninghub.phsa.ca/Learner/Home>



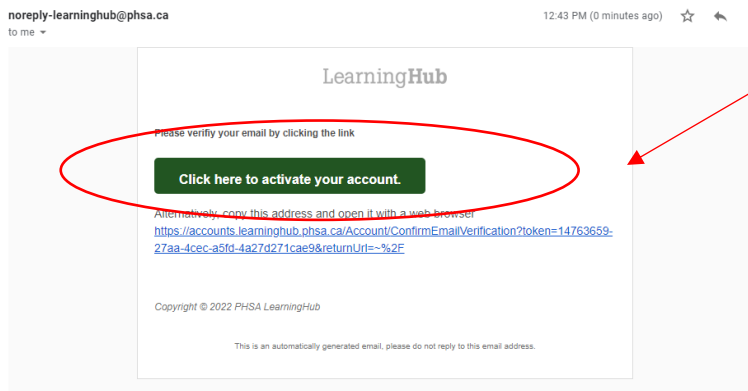
Click to 'New to LearningHub? Sign up for an account'

Create a new account by filling out your Name, Email and Password in the form.



Learninghub will ask you not to create multiple accounts. Just 'continue' if you don't already have an account

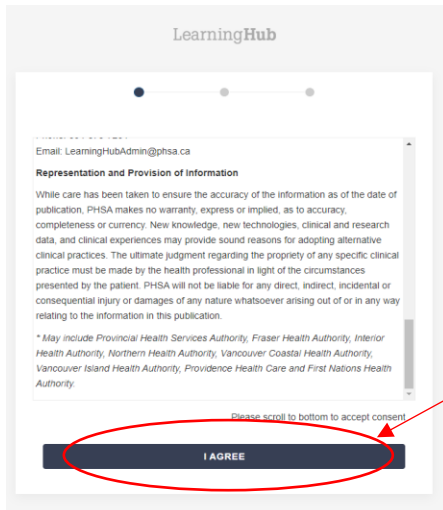
After you 'Create Account', go to your email account that you signed up with to activate the account



Click on the link in your email to activate your LearningHub account.

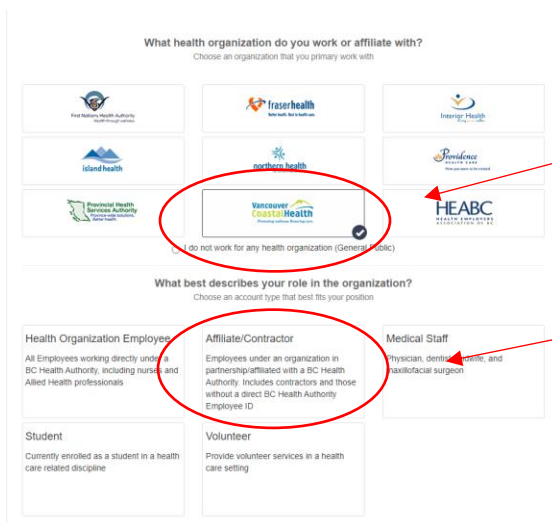
How to access Online Street Degree

To activate your account you'll need to click on 'Read and agree' to the terms and conditions (you'll need to scroll to bottom, then accept)



Click on 'Read and agree'

LearningHub will ask what organization you work for. If you're working for VCH, or in harm reduction or overdose in the VCH area, you can choose VCH. It will ask about your role, if you are an employee of a community organization (like an OPS or housing site), choose "Affiliate/ Contractor".




Choose 'Vancouver Coastal Health' if you're within the VCH region

How to access Online Street Degree

Fill in your Profile with your name and work information. The items with a red * (Name, agency, title) are required and the rest are optional. Click “complete profile”.



How to access Online Street Degree

Once you are logged into your Learning Hub account, you can search for 'Online Street Degree' in the search field:



You should see several courses pop up from your search including:

- Online Street Degree - Advanced Overdose Response (course code: 27846)
- Online Street Degree - First Responders Collab (course code: 28486)
- Online Street Degree - Managing Medical Emergencies (course code: 28485)



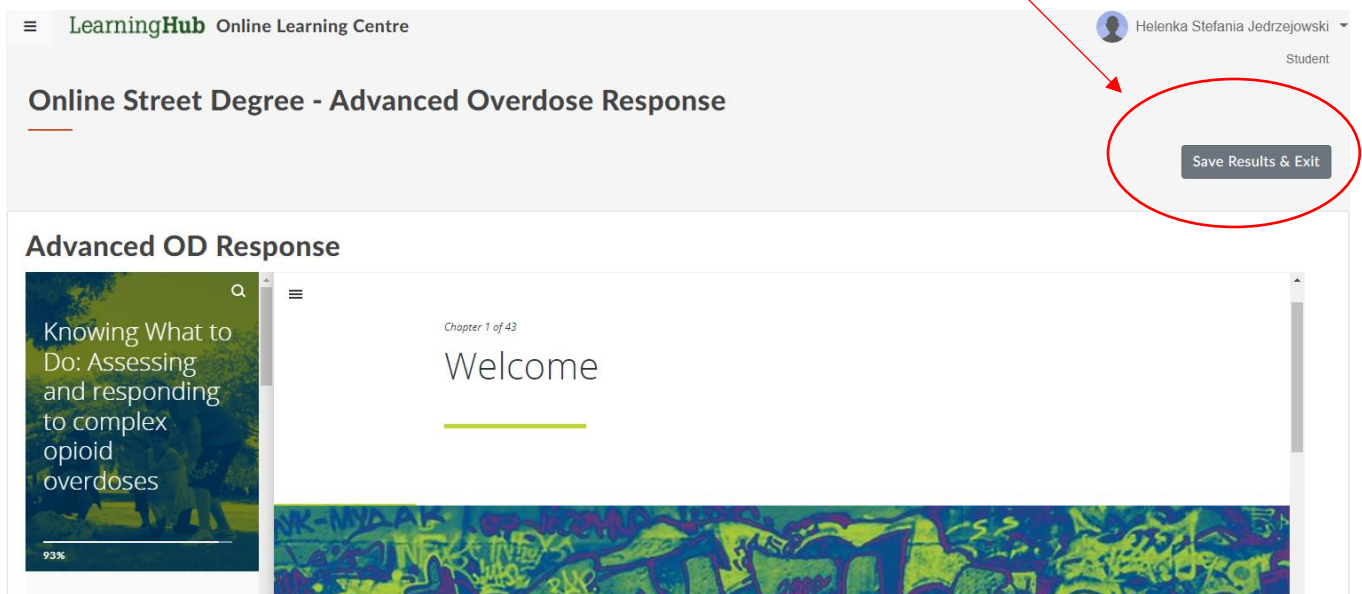
